

Release Notes Command Mobile Plus App 5.2.0

October 2023

Introduction

These release notes pertain to the software release version 5.2.0 for the Command Mobile Plus app.

March Networks Command™ Mobile Plus offers video viewing options combined with Transactions Reports from Searchlight, enabling user insights into transactions synchronized with video channels. It also integrates the enhancements to its reports and dashboards offered by the Searchlight Cloud service.

Command Mobile Plus continues to offers flexible viewing options from your mobile phone or Apple and Android tablets. Crop and stretch any view, and toggle between camera layouts. Zoom in and out on any scene and choose a multi-grid view to see several camera angles at once. Replay desired recorded footage by using the calendar icon on your device, and if you notice something suspicious, take a snapshot of your camera view and send it via email or through other communication applications on your phone. Fast forward and rewind recorded footage and switch between high, low and auto viewing mode based on the video quality you desire.

What's New in Version 5.2.0?

- **Navigation by Map** Command Mobile Plus now allows quick navigating to video resources by icons superimposed on the site, terrain map.
- **Searchlight Sites Navigation** Command Mobile Plus now allows navigating in Searchlight sites, allowing users to easier access the resources associated to the sites and terminal.
- Audio Controls Command Mobile Plus now allows switching the audio streams on and off from the options toolbar.
- Audio Support on iOS Devices Command Mobile Plus now supports audio captured by microphones connected to the cameras also on iOS devices. This feature is currently supported for cameras that support the AAC o G.771 audio codecs.
- **Text Insertion Display** Command Mobile Plus now supports displaying the text associated to a camera. It is possible to customize the text size and appearance.

Known Issues and Limitations

Issue Description	Affects
When connecting using webRTC, the connection might take up to 30 seconds.	
It is possible to experience some stability issues when connecting using an old device.	
Landscape mode is disabled for camera views on smartphones.	
Streams are limited to 1 FPS when displaying a camera view on old devices.	
In the Transaction Reports page, the icon associated to the transaction might not represent the transaction type (credit card, cash, etc.).	
In the Notifications page, sometimes results are not displayed. Workaround: Tap the Search button to make the results appear.	iOS/Android
Fast forward and rewind are limited to the speed of 4x on iOS devices.	iOS
Sometimes the logical tree in the topology is not displayed properly in the app.	iOS
The app might randomly crash when swiping through cameras in single mode if you are using high-resolution cameras (i.e. Oncam EVO 12 or ME6 cameras).	
It is possible to experience issues with the app layout using Google Pixel devices.	Android
When viewing archived video evidence, the video playback might jump a few seconds after switching from pause to play.	Android
Sometimes the video quality settings do not work properly on Android devices.	Android
Oncam cameras might show a green globe while swiping in single mode	Android
The Searchlight pages might not give results. Workaround: Log out the CES and then log on to the server.	
Snapshot for a zoomed image contains the image the default zoom level.	Android
Zooming it on a video in playback mode on a Searchlight page might cause the page title and left menu to disappear. Workaround: Zoom out to make the page title and left menu reappear.	
When pausing a video in playback mode, the zoom level might return to the default level.	Android
